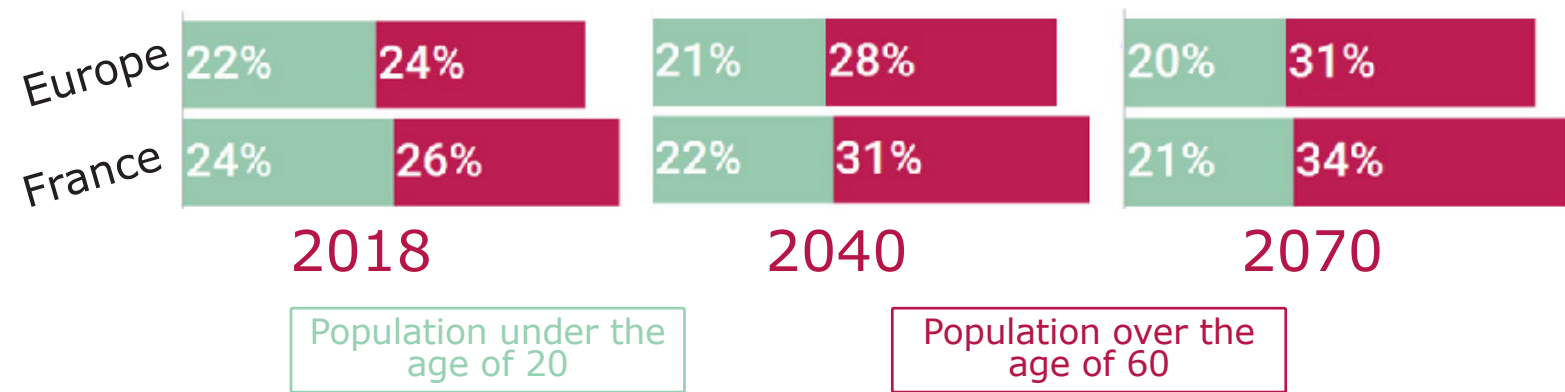

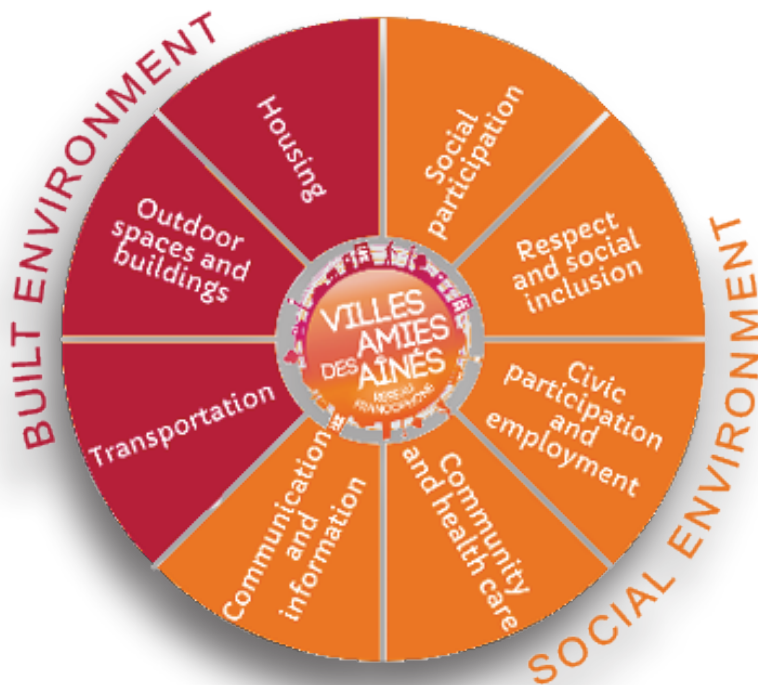


🕒 The Age-Friendly Cities Approach is an initiative of the World Health Organisation (WHO).
